Rules for Addition Top-It

Materials: deck of cards (without face cards)

Directions:

- 1. Mix or shuffle the cards and place them in a pile facedown between the two players.
- 2. One player turns over two cards and says the sum of the numbers.
- 3. The other player turns over the next two cards and says the sum of the numbers.
- 4. The player with the higher sum takes all four cards.
- 5. In case of a tie, each player draws one more card to ad to the sum. The higher sum wins all the cards.
- 6. Play ends when not enough cards remain for both players to have another turn. The winner is the player with more cards.

Variation: Children flip a coin to determine whether the player with more or fewer cards is the winner.
