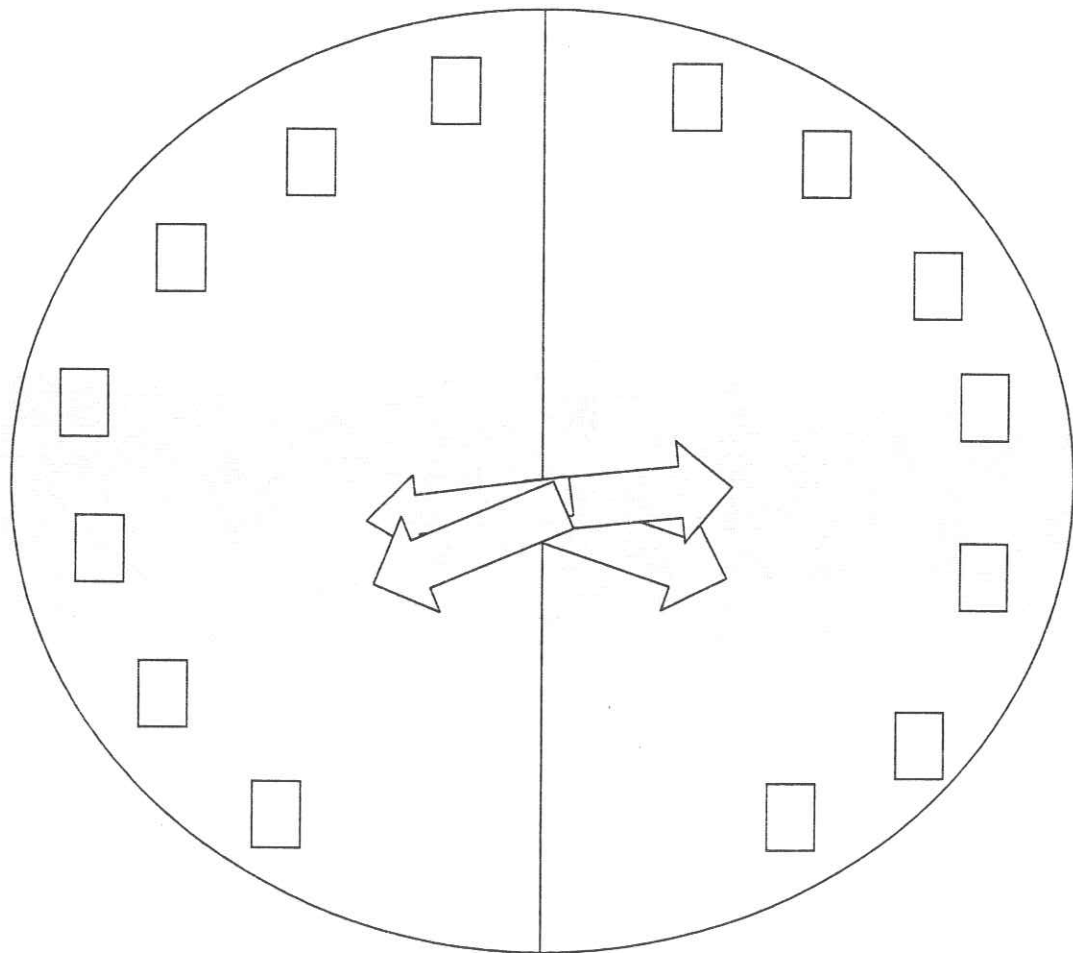
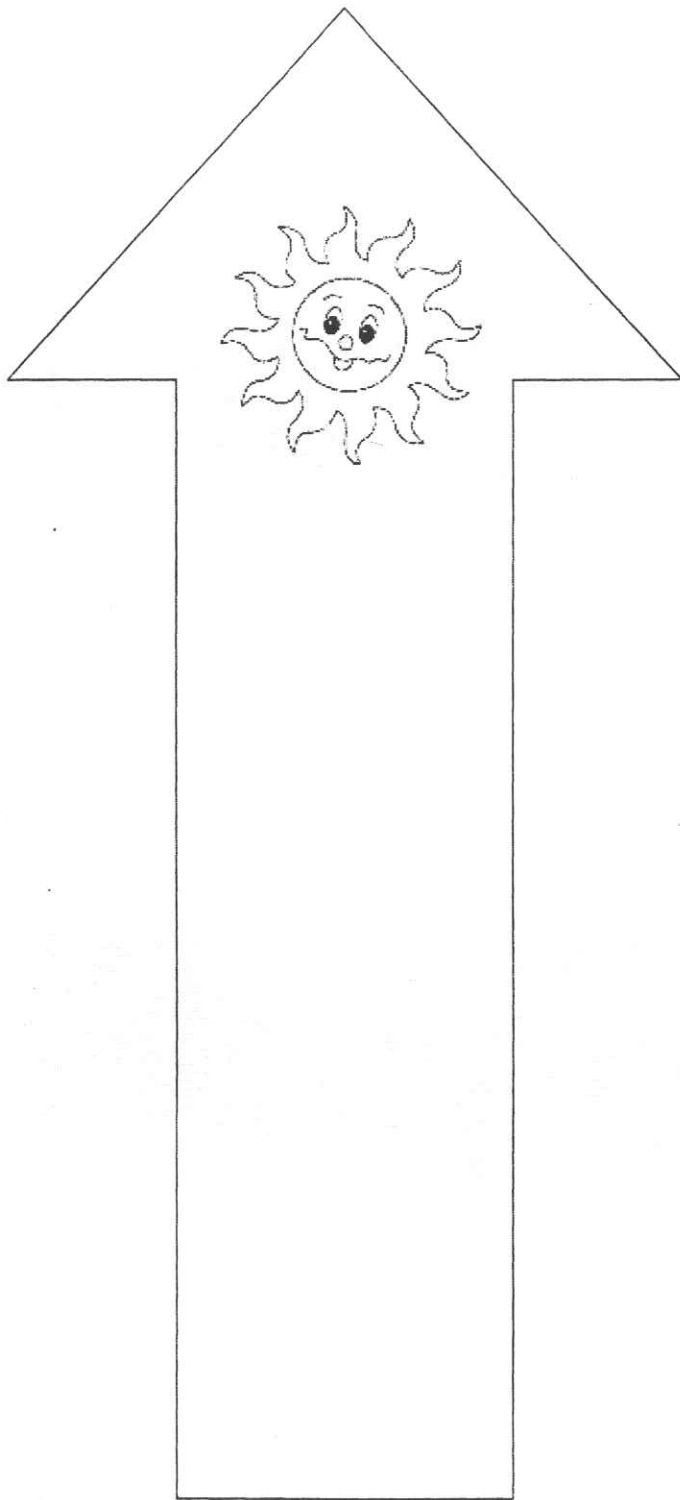


INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE DAYTIME/NIGHTTIME PATTERN CIRCLE

1. Make a large circle (the entire size of a poster board) on yellow and black paper. Cut the circle exactly in half and tape a yellow and a black half together.
2. Make a copy of the sun and moon arrow (attached blackline) on white paper.
3. Make two identical copies of the shape of the arrow with black construction paper.
4. You should have four arrows. Put the arrows in the following order, starting at the top: black arrow, sun arrow, black arrow, moon arrow.
5. Punch a hole at the bottom end of the arrow through all of the arrows (the hole should be centered on all of them).
6. Attach the arrows with a large brad to the center of the circle.
7. Notice from the illustration below how you can rotate the arrows.
8. As you rotate between the day and nighttime activities, you can cover the arrows you don't want showing with the black arrow. This way, when it is daytime (yellow) you only see the sun arrow, and the moon arrow is only shown for nighttime activities. Glue the activity cards along the perimeter of the picture (represented by the squares along the perimeter of the illustration below).
